



Vaccine guidelines for your dog

These guidelines may vary dependent on; DVM exam, breed, weight and you and your pet's lifestyle.

8 weeks	DAP #1 Bordetella oral Fecal <i>Start monthly heart worm, flea, and tick prevention</i>	Distemper/Adenovirus/Parvovirus Annual Bring fresh stool sample
12 weeks	DAP #2 Lepto#1 Fecal <i>Continue monthly heart worm, flea, and tick prevention</i>	Booster Leptospirosis Need 2 consecutive Negative samples
16 weeks	Dap 1 year Lepto #2 Bivalent Flu #1 <i>Continue monthly heart worm, flea, and tick prevention</i>	Final booster for 1 year Final booster for 1 year Canine Flu Vaccine
20 weeks	Rabies Bivalent Flu #2 Lyme #1 <i>Continue monthly heart worm, flea, and tick prevention</i>	1 year Final booster for 1 year Tickborne disease
24 weeks	Lyme #2 <i>Continue monthly heart worm, flea, and tick prevention</i>	Final booster for 1 year
Spay or neuter recommended at 6 months. (May advise differently depending on breed)
